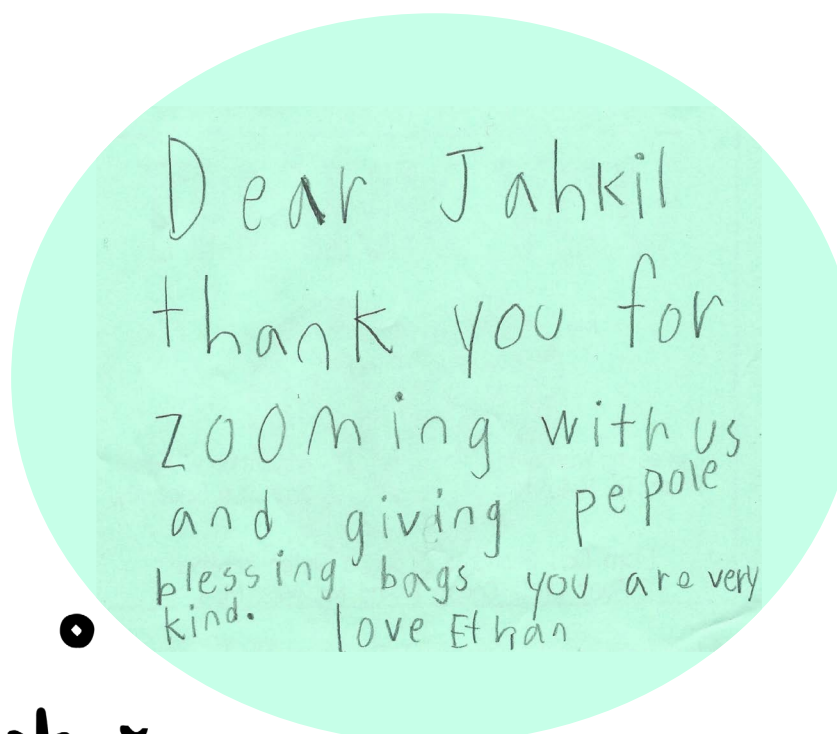
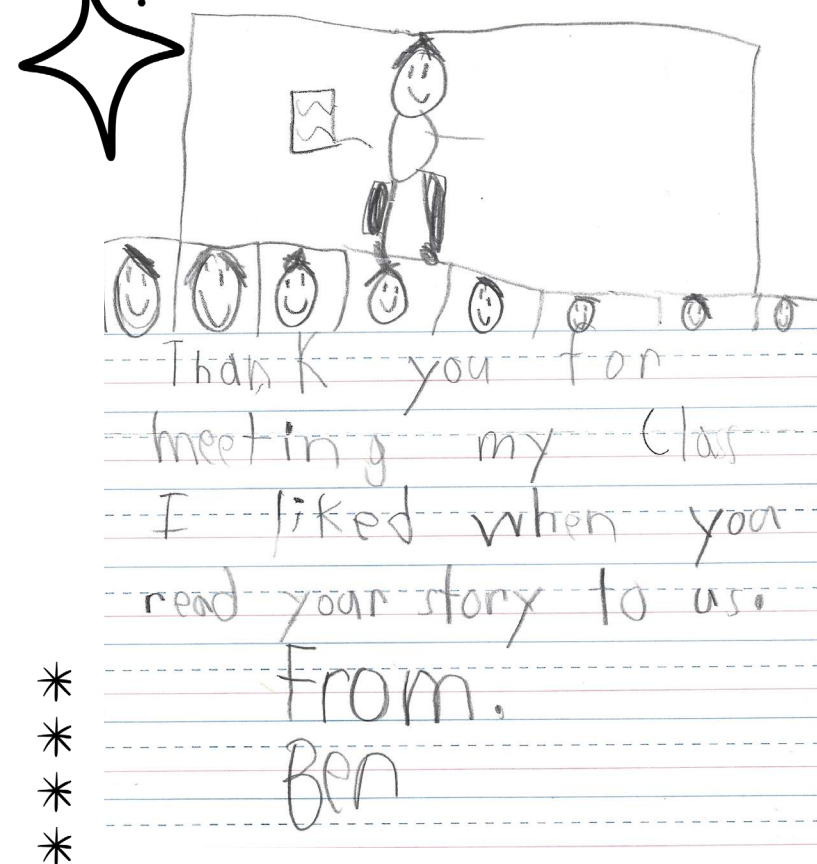

As the 17-year-old founder of Project I AM, I am thrilled to share this year's Impact Report with you—a reflection of the incredible work we've accomplished together. What began as a simple act of kindness on a cold winter night with my aunt has transformed into a life-long mission. At just five years old, my innocent view of the world was shattered when I witnessed the harsh reality of homelessness. That night planted a seed in me—a deep desire to create change.

With the unwavering support of my family, I founded Project I AM to raise awareness about homelessness and provide temporary relief for those in need. Nearly nine years later, our impact has reached close to 200,000 men, women, and children globally. We've grown to include Project I Am: Next Up, a network of young ambassadors across Florida, Illinois, Georgia, Missouri, and France, with plans to expand to Dallas, Spain, and Canada in 2025.

This work would not be possible without the support of corporations, volunteers and school administrations that have generously contributed their time, resources, and expertise. 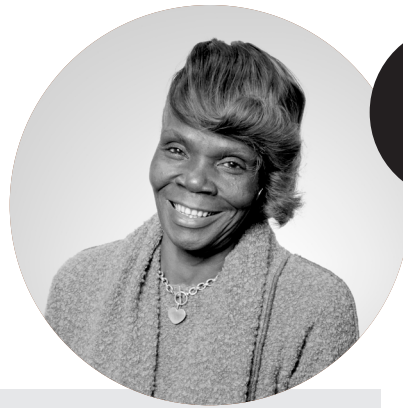

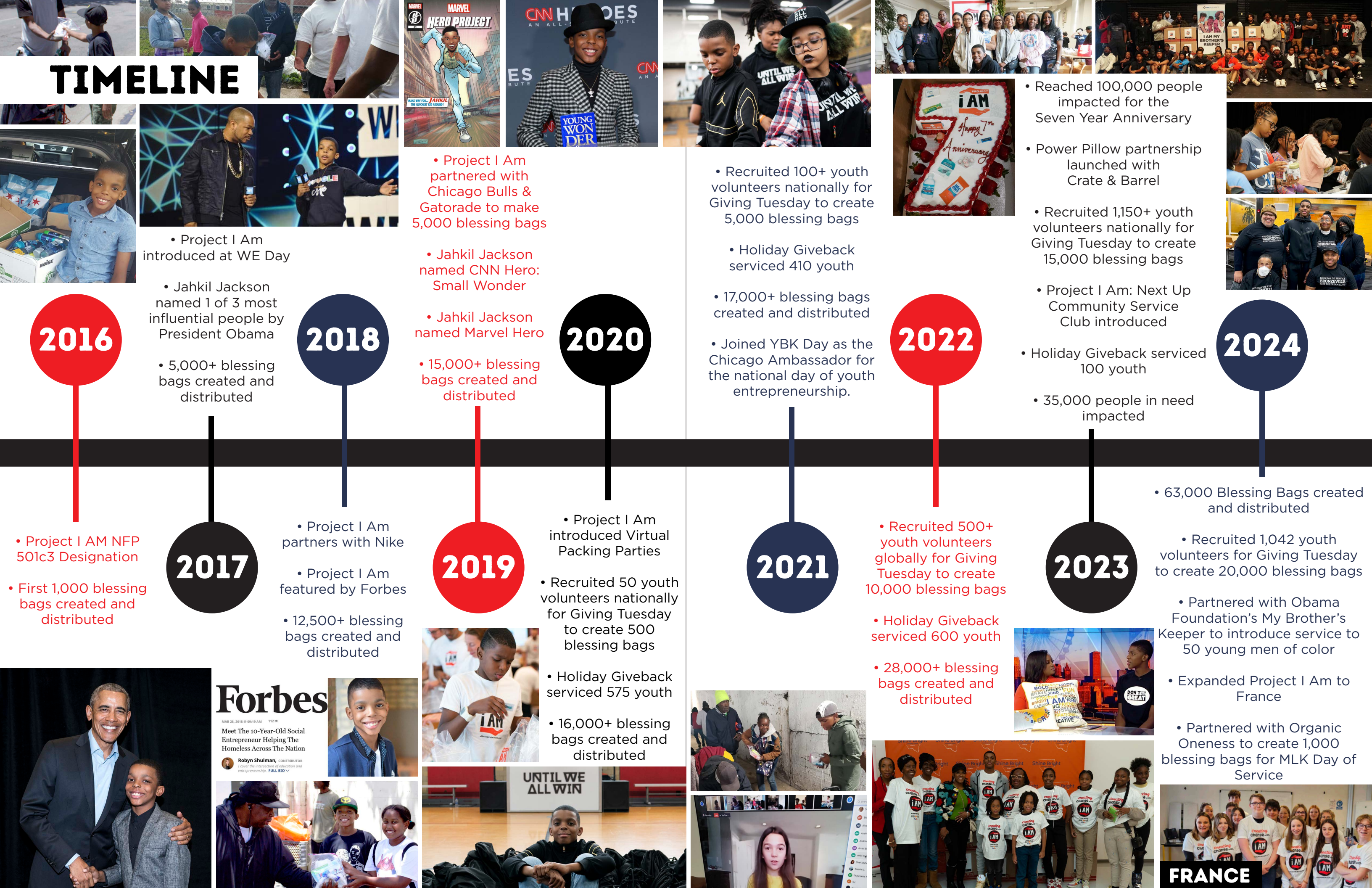

The goal is to help youth see their potential, expose them to new opportunities and ultimately help shape productive society members as they enter adulthood. This project is designed as an expansion initiative for Project I Am to become a global organization, implementing Afterschool Community Service Clubs. In 2024, expansion was successful in Florida, Missouri, Illinois and France.

DON'T WAIT TO BE GREAT 2.0

Due to the overwhelming demand for guidance, Jahkil created Don't Wait to Be Great Social Entrepreneurship Workshop Series which brings community service and entrepreneurship together into one program designed to educate and enrich youth using classroom instruction and hands-on activities focused on the importance of philanthropy and entrepreneurship. In 2024, 60 students from Heritage Elementary School participated in the on-going workshop series, creating service-oriented businesses around poverty, animal protection and the environment.

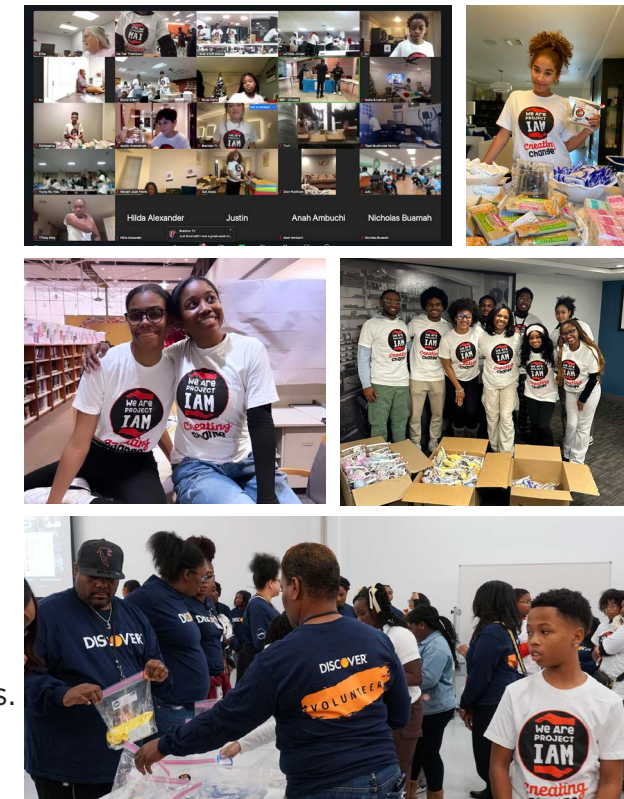


GIVING TUESDAY

Giving Tuesday is as a global generosity movement unleashing the power of people and organizations to transform their communities and the world. Project I Am introduced Virtual Packing Parties in 2020 when the world was in COVID quarantine with 50 volunteers creating 500 blessing bags simultaneously via Zoom.

2024 saw the largest Giving Tuesday impact so far with 1,000+ volunteers from 42 cities creating a record breaking 20,000 blessing bags for those in need. To date, Project I Am's Giving Tuesday initiative has worked with over 3,000 youth volunteers from over 75 cities, creating a total of 57,500 blessing bags for the unhoused in their cities.

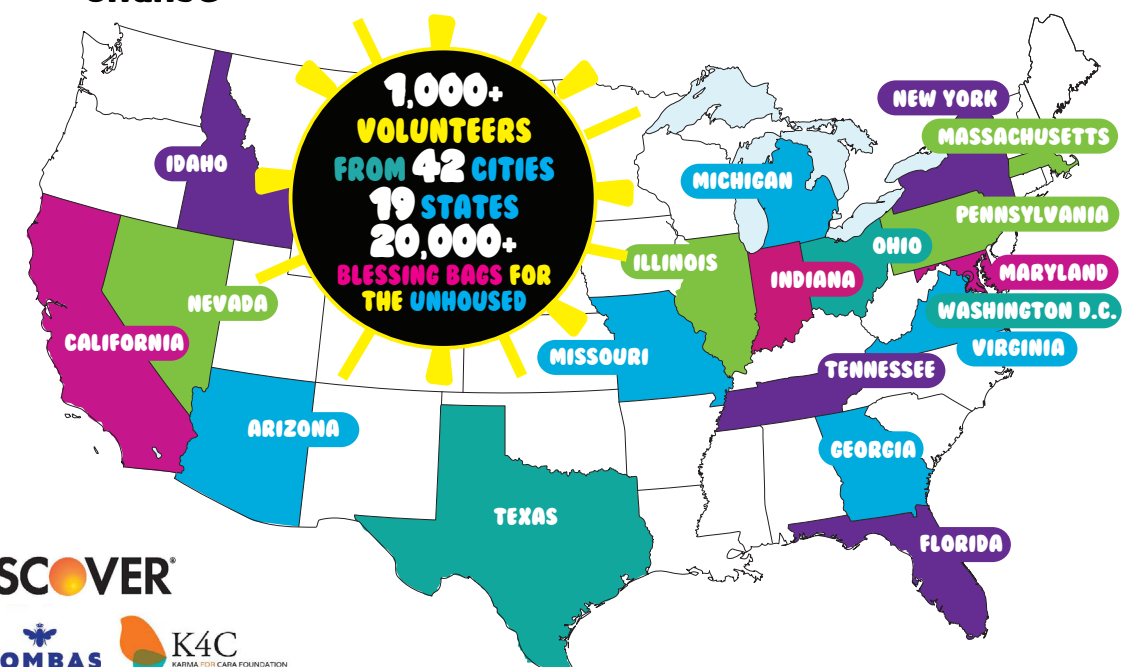
